Program Summary	<p>CaliforniaVolunteers (CV), the state service commission of California, proposes the utilization of year 6 Volunteer Generation Fund (VGF) support to further codify and implement the business model for long-term sustainability of the CaliforniaVolunteers Service Enterprise Initiative (CVSEI). CVSEI has been developed using year 1-5 VGF support as an evidenced-based train-the-trainer model to increase the effectiveness and impact of nonprofit organizations through the strategic engagement of volunteers. In addition to this, CV is proposing a Service Enterprise innovation to bring the model to the public sector. In this pilot program, two consultants from California Volunteer Centers will work with the California Department of Corrections and Rehabilitation to develop tools and materials to implement Service Enterprise in state prisons. Key partners in these efforts include Points of Light (POL) as the national technical assistance and scaling partner, California Department of Corrections and Rehabilitation, and the 7 volunteer centers (affiliates) in California who have tested the model to date.</p>
