




AmeriCorps State and National Review of Tribal Investments between 2005 and 2016

- In FY2016, AmeriCorps will make the largest tribal organization investments in the past 11 years.
- FY2016 AmeriCorps funding to Tribal Organizations increased by 65% from 2012
- AmeriCorps will support 75% more grants and members in 2016 than in 2012.
