

California FY2015 AmeriCorps State & National Grant Coversheet

Below is a breakdown of the funding being awarded to California. The state competitive funding and state formula funding will be granted to California Volunteers, the governor-appointed State Service Commission. The Commission will, in turn, award grants to nonprofit organizations and/or public agencies responding to local needs across the state. In addition, funding is also being awarded to one or more national direct grantees, which are organizations headquartered in California that support AmeriCorps members serving in more than one state.

In addition to the grant funding awarded to organizations, individual AmeriCorps members who complete at least 1,700 hours of service will earn Segal AmeriCorps Education Awards valued at \$5,645. These awards may be used to pay for college or vocational training or to pay back student loans. Through the state competitive grants alone, AmeriCorps members in California are projected to earn \$«Total_Amount_of_Education_Awards_Related» in Education Awards to support their pursuit of higher education.

AmeriCorps grants support organizations that sponsor national service programs to tackle community needs in the areas of education, veterans and military families, economic opportunity, health, environmental stewardship, and disaster services. Grants, which are matched by the recipient organization, cover some of the cost of operating the program, in addition to a small stipend for the AmeriCorps member. AmeriCorps members earn an education award upon successful completion of their term of service. Programs that operate in one state only are funded through and supported by their Governor-appointed state service commission. Multi-state programs and Indian Tribes' programs are funded directly by the Corporation for National and Community Service.

Program Summary

AmeriCorps members will increase the supply and improve the quality of water through Ecosystem Restoration Trails and Waterway Management and Fuels Reduction in areas which filter headwaters and recharge aquifers used downstream. This program is in the CNCS focus areas of Environmental Stewardship and 21st Century Service Corps funding priorities. The service will occur across California.
