

Delaware FY2016 AmeriCorps State & National Grant Coversheet

Below is a breakdown of the funding being awarded to Delaware. The state competitive funding and state formula funding will be granted to the Governor's Commission on Community & Volunteer Service, the governor-appointed State Service Commission. The Commission will, in turn, award grants to nonprofit organizations and/or public agencies responding to local needs across the state.

In addition to the grant funding awarded to organizations, individual AmeriCorps members who complete at least 1,700 hours of service will earn Segal AmeriCorps Education Awards valued at \$5,775. These awards may be used to pay for college or vocational training or to pay back student loans. Through the state competitive grants alone, AmeriCorps members in Delaware are projected to earn \$294,525 in Education Awards to support their pursuit of higher education.

Program Summary

Delaware State Parks proposes to have five full-time military veterans as AmeriCorps members who will be eradicating invasive species from park lands and trails throughout the state. At the end of the first program year, the AmeriCorps members will be responsible for achieving professional certification in herbicide application, prescribed burning and chain saw instruction and removing invasive plants from 200 acres of park land and 150 miles of trails.

Program Summary

Teach For America -Delaware (TFA-Delaware) will have 36 AmeriCorps members (ACMs) who will teach for two years in 9 schools, serving low-income students in rural and urban schools across the state. At the end of the first program year, the ACMs will be responsible for significantly improving educational outcomes for approximately 1800 students and begin their long-term impact on expanding educational opportunity for low-income students. In addition, ACMs will leverage an additional 30 volunteers to support students and classrooms.
