### Program Summary

After-School All-Stars Tampa Bay (ASAS) AmeriCorps members will provide in-school and out-of-school tutoring and mentoring services to low-performing and at-risk youth at six Pinellas County public middle schools and six after-school program sites. At the end of the first program year, the AmeriCorps members will be responsible for providing services to 750 students, and 75% of program completers will improve academic performance in Language Arts and STEM. This program will focus on the CNCS focus area of Education.
