Program Summary

The City of Jacksonville will have AmeriCorps members educate residents in safety strategies to create safer neighborhoods in Jacksonville's low-income neighborhoods. At the end of the first program year, the AmeriCorps members will be responsible for providing 3,600 individuals with increased resident knowledge of crime prevention strategies.
