Program Summary

The City of Orlando AmeriCorps members will implement an academic advocacy and counseling program targeted at high school juniors and seniors and provide these services in five Orlando area high schools (Boone, Colonial, Edgewater, Jones, and Lake Nona). At the end of the first program year, the AmeriCorps members will be responsible for assisting 1,000 students complete the program by ensuring each student enrolled graduates high school successfully and has a designated future track. This program will focus on the CNCS focus area of Education.
