

Hawaii FY2016 AmeriCorps State & National Grant Coversheet

Below is a breakdown of the funding being awarded to Hawaii. The state competitive funding and state formula funding will be granted to the Hawai'i Commission on National and Community Service, the governor-appointed State Service Commission. The Commission will, in turn, award grants to nonprofit organizations and/or public agencies responding to local needs across the state.

In addition to the grant funding awarded to organizations, individual AmeriCorps members who complete at least 1,700 hours of service will earn Segal AmeriCorps Education Awards valued at \$5,775. These awards may be used to pay for college or vocational training or to pay back student loans. Through the state competitive grants alone, AmeriCorps members in Hawaii are projected to earn \$1,778,655 in Education Awards to support their pursuit of higher education.

Program Summary

Kupu proposes to have 363 AmeriCorps members who will participate in 21st Century Conservation Service Corps programming in Hawaii. At the end of the first program year, the AmeriCorps members will be responsible for improving Hawaii's public parks and lands, increasing their knowledge of environmental stewardship and/or environmentally-conscious practices, and enrolling in higher education or securing employment for themselves after their term of service. In addition, the AmeriCorps members will leverage an additional 8,000 volunteers who will be engaged in environmental service alongside AmeriCorps members.

Program Summary

The Legal Aid Society of Hawaii's AmeriCorps Project Kaulike ("Justice" and/or "Equality") proposes to have 18 members serve as navigators of the justice system to help low income individuals and families find the legal information and resources they need to solve their legal problems. Members will serve at Legal Aid offices and in courthouse based self-help centers across the State of Hawaii. At the end of the first program year, AmeriCorps members will be responsible for helping 1,545 economically disadvantaged Hawaii residents including 145 veterans or veterans' family members gain knowledge of the legal system, their legal rights and responsibilities and learn how to address their legal problem.

Program Summary

Teach For America-Hawai'i (TFA-HI) proposes to have 150 AmeriCorps members (ACMs) who will teach in over 38 high-need schools in Hawai'i, specifically on O'ahu and Hawai'i Island. At the end of the first program year, the AmeriCorps Members (ACMs) will be responsible for significantly improving educational outcomes for over 5,400 students and begin their long-term impact on expanding educational opportunity for low-income students. In addition, the ACMs will leverage an additional 100 volunteers who will support ACMs with lesson preparation and provide students' with additional, individualized attention, further advancing academic outcomes.
