

Job Corps and AmeriCorps NCCC



A Snapshot of our Partnership to Date

AmeriCorps NCCC is a full-time, team-based residential program for men and women age 18-24. Members are assigned to one of five campuses — Denver, CO; Sacramento, CA; Baltimore, MD; Vicksburg, MS; and Vinton, IA. AmeriCorps NCCC (National Civilian Community Corps) strengthens communities and develops leaders through direct, team-based national and community service. In partnership with non-profits—secular and faith based—local municipalities, state governments, federal government, national and state parks, Indian tribes, and schools, members complete service projects throughout the region they are assigned.




Moving Forward:

The graphs below analyze the Fall 2015 recruitment cycle for Job Corps applicants. NCCC is committed to ensuring the successful completion of your students' application process. Our partnership will continue to prosper with your support as you send us only the most dedicated, flexible, and passionate applicants from Job Corps.

We received 210 Job Corps students as applicants during the past recruitment class. Of those 210 applicants, 154 (77%) successfully received an invitation to serve with AmeriCorps NCCC. Once an applicant receives an invitation to serve at a regional campus, they are considered a candidate.




■ Applied and Invited ■ Applied, did not get Invited ■ Applied and arrived ■ Applied, did not arrive

Sixty-Four percent of Job Corps applicants successfully completed the AmeriCorps NCCC application process and started their service year between October 7-14, 2015. The remaining 36% of Job Corps applicants did not successfully complete the application process for various reasons. The majority of those applicants failed to schedule and complete their required phone assessment or neglected to return clearance paperwork.
