

Kentucky FY2016 AmeriCorps State & National Grant Coversheet

Below is a breakdown of the funding being awarded to Kentucky. The state competitive funding and state formula funding will be granted to the Kentucky Commission on Community Volunteerism and Service, the governor-appointed State Service Commission. The Commission will, in turn, award grants to nonprofit organizations and/or public agencies responding to local needs across the state.

In addition to the grant funding awarded to organizations, individual AmeriCorps members who complete at least 1,700 hours of service will earn Segal AmeriCorps Education Awards valued at \$5,775. These awards may be used to pay for college or vocational training or to pay back student loans. Through the state competitive grants alone, AmeriCorps members in Kentucky are projected to earn \$2,083,135 in Education Awards to support their pursuit of higher education.

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Program Summary

The MSUCorps Program proposes to have 30 AmeriCorps members who will provide evidence-based math and reading tutoring in local elementary and middle schools using technology-based interventions to high-risk, economically disadvantaged students in 22 counties in Eastern Kentucky. At the end of the first program year, the AmeriCorps members will be responsible for 765 students (85% of 900 students enrolled in tutoring) increasing their math and reading skills by one level gain according to Measures of Academic Progress (MAP) and STAR assessment data and 630 students showing more academically engaged behaviors as demonstrated on teacher pre/post-test surveys.

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Program Summary

The UNITE Service Corps (USC) seeks to place 54 full-time USC members in 54 of the poorest elementary schools in Eastern Kentucky. The USC program is a two-fold approach to provide math tutoring and wellness curriculum to address drug prevention and nutritional education for 4th and 5th grade students. The 54 USC members will leverage an additional 1,100 volunteers to help with activities at their assigned schools. At the end of the grant period, September 1, 2016 - August 31, 2017, expected outcomes are for students to show a 30% increase in both math scores and the healthy choices curriculum as measured by pre/post tests. This project will implement services for the CNCS focus areas of Education and Healthy Futures.

Teach For America--Kentucky (TFA-KY) will have 46 AmeriCorps (AC) members who will teach for two years in low-income rural schools across the central Appalachian school districts in southeastern Kentucky. In addition, the AC members will leverage an additional 90 volunteers who will coach and develop AC teachers, provide guest lectures in classrooms, work one-on-one and with small groups of students for remediation, and coach students through college and technical school applications.
