Program Summary

The New American Integration Program’s AmeriCorps Members will provide job readiness, citizenship and English language instruction in Greater Boston, the North Shore, the South Shore, the South Coast, the Merrimack Valley, and the MetroWest regions of Massachusetts. At the end of the first program year, the AmeriCorps members will be responsible for assisting 1,700 economically disadvantaged, immigrant, and refugee adults to learn English, become US citizens, and/or obtain employment. The program will focus on the CNCS focus area of Economic Opportunity.
