### Program Summary

Student Conservation Association, Inc. – Massachusetts will utilize AmeriCorps members to increase statewide environmental stewardship by providing environmental education to underserved rural schools in Franklin, Hampshire, Berkshire and Hampden counties in Western MA, providing environmental literacy training at state parks throughout the state, and completing high priority conservation projects such as trail building, habitat monitoring, and open space restoration across the Commonwealth. This program will focus on the CNCS focus area of Environmental Stewardship.
