

## Maryland FY2017 AmeriCorps Grant Awards

Below is the FY2017 AmeriCorps grant funding breakdown for Maryland. State formula and state competitive funding will be awarded to the Governor-appointed Office on Service and Volunteerism. National direct funding will be awarded to grantees headquartered in Maryland that are operating in more than one state. Maryland AmeriCorps members will also receive post-service Segal AmeriCorps Education Awards to help pay for post-secondary education or pay down student loans. These funding streams all factor into the total award received, shown here:

In addition to the federal funding from CNCS, these AmeriCorps grantees will leverage an additional **\$15,240,124** in matching support and other resources. Together, they will engage a total of **1,581** AmeriCorps members in national service.
