Program Summary

Teach For America - Maryland AmeriCorps members will be responsible for teaching for two years in low-income and disadvantaged schools in Baltimore City, Baltimore County, and Prince George's County, going above and beyond traditional expectations to help their students achieve at high levels. At the end of the first program year, the AmeriCorps members will increase the academic achievement of the 15,057 students they teach. In addition, the AmeriCorps members will leverage an additional 239 volunteers who will support students in classrooms and schools. This program will focus on the CNCS focus area of Education.
