

Missouri FY2016 AmeriCorps State and National Grant Coversheet

Below is a breakdown of the funding being awarded to Missouri. The state competitive funding and state formula funding will be granted to Missouri Community Service Commission, the governor-appointed State Service Commission. The Commission will, in turn, award grants to nonprofit organizations and/or public agencies responding to local needs across the state. In addition, funding is also being awarded to one or more national direct grantees, which are organizations headquartered in Missouri that support AmeriCorps members serving in more than one state.

In addition to the grant funding awarded to organizations, individual AmeriCorps members who complete at least 1,700 hours of service will earn Segal AmeriCorps Education Awards valued at \$5,775. These awards may be used to pay for college or vocational training or to pay back student loans. Through the state competitive grants alone, AmeriCorps members in Missouri are projected to earn \$983,010 in Education Awards to support their pursuit of higher education.

### Program Summary

Boys Hope Girls Hope proposes to have 31 AmeriCorps members who will support Boys Hope Girls Hope's efforts to reach 800 young people, ages 10-18 who have barriers to school success and college matriculation related to poverty, providing the support necessary to progress to self-sufficiency through educational success and opportunity. Members will serve in Arizona, California, Missouri, Ohio, Louisiana, Texas, Illinois, New York, Maryland, Colorado and Michigan. They will work as teams at each project site, and focus their efforts so that each of the participating students is accruing the necessary skills, confidence and aspirations necessary to college enrollment. Their activities will focus on academic preparation, college counseling, facilitating participation in co-curricular learning and, developing opportunities for scholars to acquire cultural wealth through service-learning, parental involvement, and community education that creates collaboration across the community. In addition, AmeriCorps members will leverage 1200 volunteers who will serve as tutors and mentors. This program will focus on the CNCS focus area of Education. The CNCS investment of \$ 325,228 will be matched with \$579,477 in private funding.

### Program Summary

The Missouri College Advising Corps (MCAC) AmeriCorps Program will have 40 AmeriCorps members who will provide college advisement services to students and their families in 41 high-need high schools in 28 school districts in 14 counties in Kansas City, St. Louis, and rural south central, central, and southeast Missouri. At the end of the first program year, the AmeriCorps members will be responsible for increasing the college-going rates in partner schools over previous year's rates and as compared to a 3-year average baseline. In addition, the AmeriCorps members will leverage an additional 200 volunteers (who will serve a minimum of 2000 hours) who will be engaged in assisting with activities that increase likelihood of college aspirations and enrollment.
