



NCCC Advisory Board Alumni Representative Nomination Overview, Instructions and Form

Summary

Upon the establishment of the National Civilian Community Corps (NCCC) program in 1994 the Advisory Board was formed to advise the National Director on issues concerning the development and administration of the NCCC program. There are two alumni representatives on the Advisory Board.

There is currently 1 alumni representative position on the NCCC Advisory Board that will be available in March 2015.

Commitment

- Two year term
- Term will begin in March 2015

Responsibilities

- Commit to two year term.
- Be informed about the NCCC's mission, services, policies and programs.
- Attend three Advisory Board meetings per year at NCCC's cost.
- Attend Advisory Board functions such as graduations and inductions.
- Host teams that may be serving in your home area.
- Participate in several conference calls throughout the year.
- Participate on Advisory Board committees.
- Represent yourself, your experience, and the Corps.
- Inform others about AmeriCorps NCCC.
- Follow conflict of interest and confidentiality policies.
- Suggest possible nominees to the Advisory Board who can make significant contributions to the work of the Board and NCCC program.

Eligibility and Nomination Criteria

- Must be a former (not currently serving in any position within NCCC) NCCC member who served in one of the three previous completed class years.
- Must have served successfully in a corps member, team leader, and/or support team leader role.
- Must have successfully completed the program.
- Experience working in the service field beyond NCCC term of service is preferred but not required.
- Nominations may be submitted by current NCCC staff and members, Project Sponsors, and Alumni.
- Self nominations will also be accepted.
- Only complete nominations will be considered.

Format

- All nominations must be completed on the official nomination form.
- Typed entries are strongly encouraged.
- Attach additional sheets as needed.

Deadline

- Complete nominations are due by **5:00 PM EDT on Friday, February 13, 2015.** All materials must be received by this date and time.
- There will be no exceptions to the nomination deadline.
