

### Nebraska FY2016 AmeriCorps State & National Grant Coversheet

Below is a breakdown of the funding being awarded to Nebraska. The state competitive funding and state formula funding will be granted to ServeNebraska, the Nebraska Volunteer Service Commission, the governor-appointed State Service Commission. The Commission will, in turn, award grants to nonprofit organizations and/or public agencies responding to local needs across the state.

In addition to the grant funding awarded to organizations, individual AmeriCorps members who complete at least 1,700 hours of service will earn Segal AmeriCorps Education Awards valued at \$5,775. These awards may be used to pay for college or vocational training or to pay back student loans. Through the state competitive grants alone, AmeriCorps members in Nebraska are projected to earn \$167,475 in Education Awards to support their pursuit of higher education.

### Program Summary

College Possible Omaha proposes to have 29 AmeriCorps members who will prepare low-income students for success in post-secondary education through academic and college preparation programming in Omaha, NE. At the end of the first program year, the AmeriCorps members will be responsible for helping students demonstrate improved academic performance in literacy and math, as well as increased preparation for higher education and careers through college admission and persistence. AmeriCorps members will leverage an additional 530 volunteers. The CNCS investment of \$319,000 will be matched with other revenue totaling \$1,002,439.
