

Nevada FY2016 AmeriCorps State & National Grant Coversheet

Below is a breakdown of the funding being awarded to Nevada. The state competitive funding and state formula funding will be granted to the Nevada Volunteers, the governor-appointed State Service Commission. The Commission will, in turn, award grants to nonprofit organizations and/or public agencies responding to local needs across the state.

In addition to the grant funding awarded to organizations, individual AmeriCorps members who complete at least 1,700 hours of service will earn Segal AmeriCorps Education Awards valued at \$5,775. These awards may be used to pay for college or vocational training or to pay back student loans. Through the state competitive grants alone, AmeriCorps members in Nevada are projected to earn \$461,708 in Education Awards to support their pursuit of higher education.

Program Summary

The Great Basin Institute proposes to have 175 AmeriCorps members who will perform environmental stewardship, natural resource monitoring, evaluation, and public outreach, while engaging in workforce development. At the end of the 1st program year, the AmeriCorps members will be responsible for improving at-risk ecosystems, scientific understanding of conservation, and adaptive management practices. AmeriCorps members will leverage an additional 250 volunteers who will be engaged in restoration efforts and public outreach initiatives. The CNCS investment of \$567,438 will be matched with \$1.1 million dollars in public funding and \$350,000 in private funding.

Program Summary

The Urban Roots Garden Classroom proposes to have 22 AmeriCorps members who will teach education programs using gardens as a classroom in Reno, Sparks, Carson City, and rural northern Nevada. At the end of the first program year, the AmeriCorps members will be responsible for increasing academic engagement and preference for fruits and vegetables in children. The AmeriCorps members will leverage an additional 100 volunteers. The CNCS investment of \$184,247 will be matched with \$141,015, \$0 in public funding and \$141,015 in private funding.
