

New Jersey FY2016 AmeriCorps State & National Grant Coversheet

Below is a breakdown of the funding being awarded to New Jersey. The state competitive funding and state formula funding will be granted to the New Jersey Commission on National and Community Service, the governor-appointed State Service Commission. The Commission will, in turn, award grants to nonprofit organizations and/or public agencies responding to local needs across the state.

In addition to the grant funding awarded to organizations, individual AmeriCorps members who complete at least 1,700 hours of service will earn Segal AmeriCorps Education Awards valued at \$5,775. These awards may be used to pay for college or vocational training or to pay back student loans. Through the state competitive grants alone, AmeriCorps members in New Jersey are projected to earn \$242,550 in Education Awards to support their pursuit of higher education.

Program Summary

The State of New Jersey in partnership with Center for Family Services and the City of Camden launched PowerCorps Camden, a program that deploys 60 AmeriCorps members annually to maintain parks, storm water inlets, and other green infrastructure projects in Camden City. The three-year CNCS investment of \$390,780.00 per year for three years will be matched with an additional \$374,200 per year for three years from Camden City, the Camden County Municipal Utilities Authority, Center For Family Services, and the Camden County Parks Department.

Program Summary

FoodCorps proposes placing 12 full-time AmeriCorps members who will connect children in public schools to healthy food through nutrition education, school gardens, and improved school lunch offerings throughout New Jersey. At the end of the first program year, the AmeriCorps members will be responsible for improving children's preferences toward eating healthy foods. AmeriCorps members will leverage 360 community volunteers. The CNCS fixed amount investment of \$151,320 represents 33% of the budget needed to support these members. FoodCorps will leverage private funding to support each AmeriCorps member from sources including an anonymous donor, New Profit, Inc., The William K. Bowes Jr. Foundation, and FoodCorps general funds.
