

### North Dakota FY2016 AmeriCorps State & National Grant Coversheet

Below is a breakdown of the funding being awarded to North Dakota. The state competitive funding and state formula funding will be granted to the North Dakota State Commission on National and Community Service, the governor-appointed State Service Commission. The Commission will, in turn, award grants to nonprofit organizations and/or public agencies responding to local needs across the state.

In addition to the grant funding awarded to organizations, individual AmeriCorps members who complete at least 1,700 hours of service will earn Segal AmeriCorps Education Awards valued at \$5,775. These awards may be used to pay for college or vocational training or to pay back student loans. Through the state competitive grants alone, AmeriCorps members in North Dakota are projected to earn \$84,144 in Education Awards to support their pursuit of higher education.

### Program Summary

The West Fargo Public Schools-North Dakota Reading Corps will have 41 AmeriCorps members who will provide literacy interventions to students age 3 to grade 3 in Fargo, West Fargo, Jamestown, Bismarck and Mandan, North Dakota. At the end of the 1st program year, the AmeriCorps members will be responsible for 60 PreK students demonstrating improvement in early literacy skills and 456 K-3 students improving academic performance in literacy. AmeriCorps members will leverage an additional 82 volunteers.
