Program Summary

Heart of Oregon Corps AmeriCorps members will conduct environmental stewardship projects in the geographically isolated and economically depressed central region of Oregon that encompasses three counties (Deschutes, Jefferson, and Crook) and tribal lands within the Confederated Tribes of Warm

Springs, while improving their own economic opportunities. This program will focus on the CNCS focus areas of Economic Opportunity and Environmental Stewardship.
