

Ohio FY2016 AmeriCorps State & National Grant Coversheet

Below is a breakdown of the funding being awarded to Ohio. The state competitive funding and state formula funding will be granted to ServeOhio, the governor-appointed State Service Commission. The Commission will, in turn, award grants to nonprofit organizations and/or public agencies responding to local needs across the state.

In addition to the grant funding awarded to organizations, individual AmeriCorps members who complete at least 1,700 hours of service will earn Segal AmeriCorps Education Awards valued at \$5,775. These awards may be used to pay for college or vocational training or to pay back student loans. Through the state competitive grants alone, AmeriCorps members in Ohio are projected to earn \$2,743,125 in Education Awards to support their pursuit of higher education.

City Year Cleveland proposes to have 50 full-time AmeriCorps members who will provide academic services that support students in staying in school and on track to graduation in 6 Cleveland public schools. At the end of the first program year, the AmeriCorps members will be responsible for providing in-class and school climate support to benefit 1,200 students and targeted tutoring and mentoring to 450 students that improves 310 drop out risk indicators in attendance, behavior, English and/or math. The AmeriCorps members will leverage 175 volunteers. The CNCS investment of \$560,284 will be matched with \$560,284 in public school district funding.

City Year Columbus proposes to have 36 full-time AmeriCorps members who will provide academic services that support students in staying in school and on track to graduation in 4 Columbus public schools. At the end of the first program year, the AmeriCorps members will be responsible for providing in-class and school climate support to benefit 800 students and targeted tutoring and mentoring to 360 students that improves 642 drop out risk indicators in attendance, behavior, English and/or math. The AmeriCorps members will leverage 450 volunteers. The CNCS investment of \$403,404 will be matched with \$403,405 [\$317,500 in public and district funding and \$85,905 in private funding].

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Program Summary

The College Now Greater Cleveland will have 70 AmeriCorps members who will deliver programs on college, career exploration, and financial education to 6th through 12th graders; give support to 11th and 12th graders on postsecondary access and financial planning; and facilitate postsecondary transitions, ongoing financial education with high school graduates in 10 Ohio communities. At the end of the 1st program year, the AmeriCorps members will ensure that 7,000 of the students complete at least one advising session and one milestone on their path to postsecondary education. The AmeriCorps members will leverage an additional 560 volunteers. The CNCS investment of \$896,000 will be matched with \$549,229; \$140,450 in public funding and \$408,779 in private funding.

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Program Summary

The Educational Service Center of Central Ohio proposes to have 120 half-time AmeriCorps Members who will provide small group literacy intervention for students in kindergarten through 3rd grade who have not met reading proficiency. O-R-C Read! will take place in 29 districts in central Ohio (Delaware, Franklin, Ross, and Union counties), northeast Ohio (Cuyahoga, Lorain, and Mahoning counties), and southwest Ohio (Montgomery county). At the end of the first program year, the AmeriCorps Members will be responsible for providing intervention to a minimum 2,000 students. The AmeriCorps Members will leverage an additional 80 volunteers. The CNCS investment of \$797,937 (\$13,299/MSY) will be matched with \$480,000 in public funding.

The CNCS investment of \$329,987 matched with \$160,664 which includes local, state and federal funds in the amount of \$101,826 and \$58,838 in private funding for 26 Member Service Years (MSYs) and \$12,691.81 cost per MSY.

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Program Summary

Teach For America- Ohio proposes to have 174 AmeriCorps members who will be responsible for teaching for two years in low-income schools in Cleveland, Cincinnati, and Dayton. At the end of the first program year, the AmeriCorps Members will be responsible for increasing the academic achievement of 9,000 students. In addition, the AmeriCorps members will leverage an additional 340 volunteers. The CNCS investment of \$87,000 with an additional \$4.5 million public and private revenue will fund this project.
