Program Summary

JEVS Human Services will have TechServ Scholars AmeriCorps members will provide Science, Technology, Engineering, and Math (STEM) and digital literacy training and support in Philadelphia, Pennsylvania, and Camden, New Jersey. At the end of the first year, members will be responsible for STEM education instruction to at least 400 students in grades 5-12, and each Corps member will have attained at least one industry standard certification in a technology related field. In addition, the Corps members will leverage an additional 50 volunteers who will be engaged in supporting STEM instruction. This program will focus on the CNCS Focus Areas of education in STEM-related subject areas, and Economic Opportunity for communities by engaging Opportunity Youth serving as AmeriCorps members.
