Program Summary

ArtistYear AmeriCorps Members will provide issue-based arts education to vulnerable student populations in Title I schools in: Philadelphia, PA; Queens, NY; and the Roaring Fork School District, CO. At the end of the first program year, AmeriCorps Members will have facilitated completion of ArtistYear Citizen-Artist programs to economically disadvantaged youth, English Language Learners (ELLs), and students of color. The program will demonstrate improved academic engagement, increased artistic skill and self-concept, and increased civic engagement. ArtistYear will focus on the CNCS focus area of Education.
