

## Tennessee FY2016 AmeriCorps State & National Grant Coversheet

Below is a breakdown of the funding being awarded to Tennessee. The state competitive funding and state formula funding will be granted to Volunteer Tennessee, the governor-appointed State Service Commission. The Commission will, in turn, award grants to nonprofit organizations and/or public agencies responding to local needs across the state.

In addition to the grant funding awarded to organizations, individual AmeriCorps members who complete at least 1,700 hours of service will earn Segal AmeriCorps Education Awards valued at \$5,775. These awards may be used to pay for college or vocational training or to pay back student loans. Through the state competitive grants alone, AmeriCorps members in Tennessee are projected to earn \$2,557,880 in Education Awards to support their pursuit of higher education.

The Emerald Youth Foundation proposes to have 55 AmeriCorps members who will serve in afterschool/summer and tutoring programs in Knoxville's inner city. The AmeriCorps members will leverage an additional 150 volunteers who will be engaged in tutoring, fitness activities, and general program support. This program will focus on the CNCS focus area of Education. The CNCS investment of \$190,617 will be matched with \$190,617 in private funding.

### Program Summary

Porter-Leath proposes to have 24 AmeriCorps members who will provide educational enrichment activities for Porter-Leath Early Childhood students in the agency's Head Start centers in Memphis and Shelby County. At the end of the first program year, the AmeriCorps members will be responsible for increasing Brigance Inventory of Basic Skills assessment scores for 480 students who score significantly below their age range and/or have an established Individual Education Plan. In addition, the AmeriCorps members will leverage over 120 additional volunteers that will be engaged in literacy initiatives throughout the same centers. The CNCS investment of \$322,320 will be matched with \$322,320 in private funding.

### Program Summary

Teach For America-Memphis proposes to have 250 AmeriCorps members (ACMs) who will teach in approximately 100 high-need schools, including traditional Shelby County public schools, the Achievement School District (ASD), and a number of independent charter networks. At the end of the first program year, the ACMs will be responsible for significantly improving educational outcomes for over 9,700 students and begin their long-term impact on expanding educational opportunity for low-income students. In addition, the ACMS will leverage an additional 250 volunteers. The CNCS investment of \$125,000 will be supplemented with other revenue-- \$200,000 in federal funding and 6.8M in private funding.

In addition, AC members will leverage at least 230 volunteers to engage in tutoring students, supporting classrooms, and providing professional development. With the CNCS investment of \$108,000 we will leverage an additional \$6.5M in private and public funding.

### Program Summary

Tennessee's Community Assistance Corporation proposes to have 17.38 Member Service Years 44 slots at \$13,300 cost per MSY. Making Veterans Priority AmeriCorps members will be serving in the following cities Jefferson City, Morristown, Johnson City, Kingsport, Knoxville, Greeneville, Columbia, Cleveland, LaFayette and Chattanooga. At the end of the first program year, the AmeriCorps members will be responsible for completing 35 home repairs and 2500 transitional resources and referrals. The AmeriCorps members will leverage an additional 300 volunteers who will be engaged in home repair projects for Veterans. The CNCS investment of \$231,154 will be matched with \$275,630 (\$123,680 in-kind + \$151,950 cash) in private funding.
