Program Summary

The Student Conservation Association will have AmeriCorps members preserve, protect, and increase energy efficiency on public lands and structures as well as educate visitors on environmentally-conscious building practices with local, state, and federal partners including the National Park Service, National Forest Service, and the Fish and Wildlife Service in Alaska, Arizona, Colorado, Delaware, Louisiana, Massachusetts, New York, Pennsylvania, South Carolina, Texas, Utah, and Washington. At the end of the first program year, the AmeriCorps members will be responsible for improving 160 acres of public lands, improving over 95 miles of historic trails and waterways, and completing 12 historic preservation projects. In addition, the AmeriCorps members will leverage an additional 90 volunteers who will be engaged in historic preservation projects. This program will focus on the CNCS focus area of Environmental Stewardship and the user focus area of Historic Preservation.
