Types of AmeriCorps Programs

- AmeriCorps State and National
 - Broadest network of programs
 - Programs are either awarded from a (1) **State Commission** that oversees service within a state, (2) **National program** and operate in more than one state, or (3) an **Indian Tribal Government**
- AmeriCorps Vista
 - Full-time members service non-profit and public agencies to create and expand programs that bring individuals and communities out of poverty
- AmeriCorps National Civilian Community Corps (NCCC)
 - Full-time team residential-based program for participants 18 to 24; members live on one of five campuses in Colorado, California, Maryland, Mississippi, and Iowa
