


CNCS Review of Tribal Investments between 2005 and 2015

- FY2015 CNCS Awards to Tribal Organizations increased by 29% from 2014.
- CNCS will support 81% more volunteers and members in 2015 than in 2014.
- 48% more grants to tribal organizations will be made in 2015 than in 2014.
- In 2015, AmeriCorps and Senior Corps will make the largest tribal organization investments in the past 10 years.




