- ✓ Happy hour/social time on Tuesday, September 15, 5:30-6:30 pm, in the Hyatt Lobby Bar
- ✓ Awards luncheon at 12:30 pm on Wednesday, September 16, in the Regency Ballroom
- ✓ There is no pre-registration for workshops; seating will be limited, and sessions fill up early

What to do with all your Symposium wisdom:

- ✓ Take it home and make it your own! Use the materials, concepts, and examples you receive to train your subgrantees, service sites, or AmeriCorps members to implement or improve your program, enhance your commission operations, and more

Final tips:

- ✓ There will be limited food and beverage provided by CNCS during the Symposium; coffee and tea will be provided at no cost in the mornings, and there will be a lunch buffet on September 16. Beyond that, participants are required to pay for their own meals (and the DC metro area is expensive)
