Technical Assistance (TA) resources are available for Senior Corps projects implementing the two Healthy Futures outcome measures for “aging in place”¹:

- Number of homebound OR older adults and individuals with disabilities who reported having increased social ties/perceived social support (H9)
- Number of caregivers of homebound OR older adults and individuals with disabilities who reported having increased social ties/perceived social support (H14)
