

Train-the-Trainer Topic Suggestions

Training volunteer stations and other agencies on how they can conduct site-based training can ensure that volunteers in your project receive consistent messages and are trained in the critical skills needed for success. The curriculum, *Providing Independent Living Support: Training for Senior Corps Volunteers*, and many of the identified pre-service orientation and in-service topics may be helpful for partners doing the training. Senior Corps project directors that conduct train-the-trainer sessions (i.e. train others to train volunteers) also recommend the following topics. Add your own ideas and resources to the list.
