Pasco lies immediately north of Hillsborough and Pinellas Counties, best known as the Tampa-St. Petersburg metro area, along the Gulf of Mexico. Per the 2010 U.S. Census, the population is 464,697. Prior to the economic recession, it was the 38th fastest growing county in the nation with a 34.8% increase in residents since the year 2000. The county's demographics vary from the densely populated west side with its mix of retirees and young families, to the more suburban central area dotted with newer subdivisions, to the mostly rural, agricultural east side of the county. Several portions of the county are in sharp economic decline, with some of the highest foreclosure rates in the nation, unemployment higher than state and national levels, and rising poverty.
