Foundation for a Healthy Kentucky	The Meade Activity Center is working toward a fully operationalizing a community activity center, providing structured after-school activities to low-income children, offering a broad range of nutrition and physical activity opportunities to low-income families, and providing affordable physical activity opportunities to seniors.
Burkesville, KY	Cumberland Family Medical Center, Inc. Foundation for a Healthy Kentucky	The McCreary Family Medical Center is providing approximately 800 patient encounters each month while training additional nurse practitioners and physician assistants in rural McCreary County.
Edgewood, KY	St. Elizabeth Medical Center Foundation for a Healthy Kentucky	The project establishes telepsychiatry in St. Elizabeth Hospital Emergency Departments, which provides immediate access to behavioral health consults (audio/video telemedicine) with mental health professionals for patients in Northern Kentucky.
La Grange, KY	Oldham County Health Department Foundation for a Healthy Kentucky	The Oldham County Health Department is supporting Hope Health Clinic, a free clinic for the uninsured which provides acute medical care, chronic disease management, and patient navigation.
Lexington, KY	St. Joseph Health System Foundation for a Healthy Kentucky	By improving access to care in two low-income rural Kentucky communities, St. Joseph Health System is improving general health status and chronic disease management in particular.
Louisville, KY	Home of the Innocents Foundation for a Healthy Kentucky	In collaboration with local stakeholders, Home of the Innocents is establishing a dental clinic to provide dental services to children in state care, children with special health care needs, and other children and families served by the Home and its partner agencies.
Louisville, KY	Norton Healthcare Centers for Prevention and Wellness Foundation for a Healthy Kentucky	Get Healthy Access Project is implementing a set of linked activities with the goal of reducing cardiovascular disease risk and increasing access to timely healthcare for 2,200 low-income and uninsured residents per year in some of the lowest-income communities in the Louisville Metro area, including West Louisville.
Mt Sterling, KY	Montgomery County Health Department Foundation for a Healthy Kentucky	In collaboration with local stakeholders, Montgomery County Health Department is establishing a health education/navigation program to serve a low-income population in three Appalachian counties: Montgomery, Bath and Menifee.

WIRED65 is providing skills assessments, career pathways, and training opportunities to low-income jobseekers and incumbent workers tailored to the needs identified by employer partnerships in the health care and "new auto" sectors.
Newport, KY	Brighton Center Local Initiatives Support Corporation	Brighton Center is building on their innovative combination of evidenced-based best practices in family support, education, and leadership, supported by the work of Family Development Specialists trained in multiple disciplines and serving in the role of "Navigators" of core services.
Covington, KY	Covington Independent Public Schools United Way of Greater Cincinnati (UWGC)	The Covington Independent Public Schools is transforming its Holmes High School campus to an early college high school with each of its 900+ students receiving 15 hours of college credit upon graduation.
