Newark, NJ	Community Asset Preservation Corporation NCB Capital Impact	The Community Asset Preservation Corporation Consortium is a partnership formed between five nonprofits that are conducting joint outreach, homebuyers counseling and data tracking, and creating a stewardship program for permanently affordable homes.
