New Orleans, LA	Louisiana Public Health Institute AIDS United	he overall goal of the Louisiana Reentry Initiative (LRI) is to link and retain in care formerly incarcerated individuals living with HIV infection in Louisiana. The Louisiana Public Health Institute (LPHI) in New Orleans, LA will serve as the lead agency and evaluator for this initiative. The LRI will focus on the unique retention needs of formerly incarcerated individuals living with HIV infection in the state. LPHI will collaborate with the Louisiana Office of Public Health in New Orleans, the Pennington Family Foundation, the Baton Rouge Area Foundation, and the Capitol Area Reentry Program (in partnership with the Earl K. Long Early Intervention Clinic in Baton Rouge and the Baton Rouge Area Alcohol and Drug Center, Inc.). The first 16 months of the LRI will be focused in the Baton Rouge area. The estimated number of persons to be served by the LRI is between 40-50 annually.
