Baltimore, MD	Green & Healthy Homes Initiative/Calvert Foundation (Pay for Success)	The program will assess the feasibility of five cities or counties constructing asthma-related PFS projects and provide technical assistance to healthcare organizations (including integrated delivery networks, academic medical centers, and Medicaid managed care organizations) and nonprofit service providers. One health care entity, acting as a private payor, and one service provider will be selected per site, for a total of ten project sub-recipients. This program will be based on the existing asthma-focused PFS project in Baltimore, MD, implemented by a partnership between GHHI, the Calvert Foundation and Johns Hopkins Hospital and Healthcare System.
