Chapel Hill, NC	College Advising Corps GreenLight Fund	With its subgrant to National College Advising Corps (NCAC), GreenLight's SIF Initiative will support NCAC's work to increase the number of low-income, first-generation, underrepresented students entering and completing higher education. In Boston, NCAC will work in partnership with local colleges and universities by placing recent graduates of partner institutions as college advisers in underserved high schools. Advisers work full-time to help students conduct their college searches, complete admissions and financial aid applications, and enroll at schools that will serve them well. In Boston, the Advising Corps expects to serve approximately 3,000 high school students annually in its first five years.
