Boise, ID	CATCH, Inc. University of Utah Policy Innovation Lab	Using a Housing First approach, CATCH, Inc. works with residential property managers to secure housing for families experiencing homelessness, and provide short-term rental assistance paired with progressively intensive case management to identify and address the root causes of that family's homeless episode. Families are paired with a case manager that works closely with these families to set goals and take the necessary steps to achieve these goals as well as identify the best route to financial stability for each individual family.
Boise, ID	City of Boise, ID University of Utah Policy Innovation Lab	Boise, Idaho is developing a feasibility study exploring the potential for a Pay for Success approach to chronic homelessness generally and recidivism among previously incarcerated individuals experiencing homelessness specifically. On any given day, the City of Boise estimates that 500-700 are homeless and that 50-100 of those are chronically homeless.
Nampa, ID	Terry Reilly Health Services University of Utah Policy Innovation Lab	Terry Reilly is a Boise, Idaho based nonprofit providing integrated primary care and behavioral health services to individuals experiencing limited access to financial and health care resources within Ada County, Idaho. Terry Reilly has strong partnerships with other stakeholders in the homelessness service provider community, creating a dynamic referral process, which integrates Terry Reilly's intervention into those of fellow providers.
