Saint Louis, MO	St. Louis Effort for AIDS AIDS United	<p>The BEACON Project seeks to locate and return to care PLWH in the Saint Louis region with no evidence of HIV primary care within the past year. The BEACON Project is a collaboration between the City Health Department, Saint Louis Effort for AIDS, and Washington University's Project ARK. When PLWH who are out of care are identified, they will receive services from one of the Care Navigation Teams. Each team is made up of an Engagement Coordinator (who also serves as their Ryan White Case Manager), two HIV+ Peer Advocates, and a shared Community Nurse. BEACON clients will have access to Peer Advocates to manage barriers of stigma, disclosure, and fear; support from Peer Advocates and Engagement Coordinators who assist clients in navigating social service resources; and access to the Community Nurse for education and support in managing their treatment for HIV and any other medical conditions</p>
