Carson City, NV	State of Nevada, Clark County, and City of Las Vegas Harvard Kennedy School Social Impact Bond Lab	<p>The State of Nevada, Clark County and the City of Las Vegas will receive assistance from both the SIB Lab and Third Sector Capital Partners to explore the use of Pay for Success in creating innovative strategies to improve social outcomes in early childhood education. Specifically, the three jurisdictions will engage in a feasibility study that will explore how an early childhood education PFS project can increase outcomes such as kindergarten readiness and third grade literacy as well as reduce public school special education and remedial education expenditures. The PFS project will target Southern Nevada and will be a part of Nevada's ongoing efforts to improve early childhood education opportunities state-wide. The collaborative feasibility process between the SIB Lab and Third Sector Capital Partners will focus on four main areas: (1) evaluation of whether or not proposed interventions produce the desired outcomes, (2) cost-benefit analysis of proposed interventions, (3) design of potential PFS payment structures and outreach to potential investors, and (4) assessment of the most rigorous evaluation strategies that can be used to measure the initiative's outcomes. The State of Nevada is the only Social Innovation Fund Subgrantee leading an innovative partnership between state, county and city government to address PFS contracting and savings analysis for early childhood education interventions, which has the potential to serve as a model nationwide. Additionally, the University of Utah Policy Innovation Lab will provide to the City of Las Vegas a PFS Fellow and the related training and technical assistance to develop a PFS program. The Policy Innovation Lab's technical assistance services include: (1) research and data analysis to help the City identify and describe a target population and baseline outcomes for that population; (2) financial modeling and analysis of costs of various interventions versus the benefits to the City from those interventions; (3) budget scan to identify spending priorities and potential areas for cost savings; (4) high-level project support from Lab staff; and (5) connecting the City to other PFS-related resources around the country as needed. Measureable outcomes of this program include a completed feasibility study identifying a target population, baseline outcomes, anticipated programmatic outcomes, and an estimate of cost savings / avoidance.</p>
