

### MEETING NEEDS IN ILLINOIS

Working hand-in-hand with local partners, the Corporation for National and Community Service (CNCS) is investing more than \$37.0 million this year to support cost-effective community solutions in Illinois. This federal funding enables more than 11,000 Americans of all ages and backgrounds to engage in service that meets local needs, strengthens communities, and expands economic opportunity in Illinois. AmeriCorps members and Senior Corps volunteers are preparing today's students for tomorrow's jobs, reducing crime and reviving cities, connecting veterans to services, fighting the opioid epidemic, helping seniors live independently, and rebuilding communities after disasters.

National service participants will serve at more than 1,400 locations across Illinois, including schools, food banks, homeless shelters, health clinics, youth centers, veterans' facilities, and other nonprofit and faith-based organizations. Through a unique public-private partnership, CNCS, its grantees, and project sponsors will generate more than \$46.4 million in outside resources from businesses, foundations, public agencies, and other sources in Illinois this year. This local support strengthens community impact and increases the return on taxpayer dollars.

### AMERICORPS



This year, more than 2,600 AmeriCorps members will meet pressing local needs across Illinois, making a lasting impact in communities while gaining valuable skills and experience to advance their careers. AmeriCorps members serve in one of three programs:

- **AmeriCorps State & National** engages men and women in intensive service at thousands of locations across the country through nonprofits, schools, public agencies, tribes, and community and faith-based groups. Most AmeriCorps grant funding goes to the Serve Illinois Commission on Volunteerism and Community Service, the Governor-appointed State Service Commission, which in turn awards grants to organizations to respond to local needs.
- **AmeriCorps VISTA (Volunteers In Service To America)** taps the skills, talents, and passion of Americans of all ages to support community efforts to overcome poverty.
- **AmeriCorps NCCC (National Civilian Community Corps)** is a full-time, team-based residential program for 18-24 year-olds. Members develop leadership skills by contributing to public safety, environment, and disaster projects. FEMA Corps, a unit of NCCC, focuses solely on disaster preparedness, response, and recovery.

In exchange for their service, AmeriCorps members earn a Segal AmeriCorps Education Award that can be used to pay for trade school, college, or graduate school; or to pay back qualified student loans. Since 1994, more than 45,000 Illinois residents have served approximately 64 million hours and earned education awards totaling more than \$157.0 million.

### SENIOR CORPS



Senior Corps taps the skills, talents, and experience of Americans age 55 and over to meet a wide range of community challenges. This year, more than 8,400 Illinois seniors will meet critical community needs while contributing to their own health and well-being through one of three Senior Corps programs:

- **Foster Grandparents** serve one-on-one as tutors and mentors to young people with exceptional needs.
- **Senior Companions** help seniors and other adults maintain independence in their own homes.
- **RSVP volunteers** conduct safety patrols, renovate homes, protect the environment, tutor and mentor youth, respond to natural disasters, and provide other services.

Last year, Foster Grandparents tutored and mentored 3,500 young people, Senior Companions helped 710 seniors live independently, and RSVP volunteers strengthened the impact of 680 organizations across Illinois.

Since 1994, more than 45,000 Illinois residents have served approximately 64 million hours through AmeriCorps, earning Segal AmeriCorps Education Awards totaling more than \$157.0 million.

This data represents total federal funding and resources awarded between January 7, 2019 and January 6, 2020 to support projects headquartered in Illinois.

1. For AmeriCorps State and National, the number of participants is the number of positions available to be filled for the projects in this report. For AmeriCorps VISTA and NCCC, the number of participants is the number of members who have started service since January 7, 2019. For Senior Corps, this is the total number of volunteers in the projects' grant applications.
2. The service location total may contain multiple counts of unique locations where multiple CNCS programs are operating. Service location totals may not reflect all locations that will be active during the life of the award.
3. The Education Scholarships figure represents the maximum potential value of Segal AmeriCorps Education Awards that can be earned by AmeriCorps members included in this report. The award can be used in any state to pay for college, graduate school, vocational training, or to pay back student loans.
4. The Federal Funding column for AmeriCorps State and Senior Corps reflects the full funding awarded to projects included in this report. For AmeriCorps VISTA, funding reflects the national average cost per participant for all members included in this report. All AmeriCorps NCCC funding is reported at NCCC's four regional campuses.
5. AmeriCorps National figures may include national projects headquartered in the state and/or operating sites of national projects that are headquartered in other states. Federal funding reflects the estimated proportionate share of the national grant associated with operating sites in this report. Some national organizations do not report operating site data, or it was not available at time of publishing, so figures may not reflect current conditions.
6. Total local project support reflects non-CNCS cash and in-kind resources that CNCS grantees committed to raise in support of projects and grants in this report. As part of its public-private partnership approach, CNCS grantees leverage additional resources to strengthen community impact and increase the return on the federal investment.

Since 1994, more than 45,000 Illinois residents have served approximately 64 million hours through AmeriCorps, earning Segal AmeriCorps Education Awards totaling more than \$157.0 million.

3. The Education Scholarships figure represents the maximum potential value of Segal AmeriCorps Education Awards that can be earned by AmeriCorps members included in this report. The award can be used in any state to pay for college, graduate school, vocational training, or to pay back student loans.
4. The Federal Funding column for AmeriCorps State and Senior Corps reflects the full funding awarded to projects included in this report. For AmeriCorps VISTA, funding reflects the national average cost per participant for all members included in this report. All AmeriCorps NCCC funding is reported at NCCC's four regional campuses.
5. AmeriCorps National figures may include national projects headquartered in the state and/or operating sites of national projects that are headquartered in other states. Federal funding reflects the estimated proportionate share of the national grant associated with operating sites in this report. Some national organizations do not report operating site data, or it was not available at time of publishing, so figures may not reflect current conditions.
6. Total local project support reflects non-CNCS cash and in-kind resources that CNCS grantees committed to raise in support of projects and grants in this report.
